
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Introduction

To support the growth of the digital economy, the Government intends to implement e-Invoice in stages to enhance the efficiency of Malaysia's tax administration management. This aligns with the Twelfth Malaysia Plan, where one key focus is strengthening the digital services infrastructure and digitalising the tax administration.

All businesses will be required to issue e-invoices by the phased mandatory implementation timeline based on the business's annual turnover or revenue threshold.

Targeted Taxpayers	Implementation Date
Taxpayers with an annual turnover or revenue of more than RM 100 million	1 August 2024
Taxpayers with an annual turnover or revenue of more than RM 25 million	1 January 2025
All taxpayers	1 July 2025
